ALL ENTRANTS WHO DON'T PRE-REGISTER WILL BE CHARGED A \$5.00 WALK-IN FEE PER EVENT ENTERED. PRE REGISTERED ENTRIES MUST BE POST MARKED BY MIDNIGHT OF THE THURSDAY PRIOR TO THE REQUESTED TIME OF BOWLING.

COUNTY TOURNAMENT

1. Those eligible to bowl in the tournament are: a. All members of the Butler County USBC, BA, b. All military personnel who are residents of Butler County without an USBC card will purchase an affiliate membership card for \$16. c. Non-members of the USBC living within the jurisdiction of this Association and who are not members of another association may enter by buying an affiliate membership card for \$16. d. Bowlers who have a USBC card from another association and bowl in a league under Butler County USBC BA jurisdiction and have a local card. If you don't bowl in a BCUSBCBA league you are not eligible.
2. Entries will be accepted until the start of the final squad.
3. Entrants will use their highest USBC Certified book average based on a minimum of 21 games from the 2010-2011 season, If 2011-2012 average is 10 pins or higher the higher average must be used. If no average last year, use the highest current USBC Certified average, 21 games or more, as of time of bowling. Please bring a league standing sheet for verification purposes. All other will bowl scratch.
4. It shall be the bowler's responsibility to determine that the average is correct. Failure to use the proper average shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower than actual average thereby resulting in more handicap. Familiarize yourself with USBC Rule 319D, 319E.
5. Handicap for the County Tournament will be based on 100% of the difference between entering average and 250.
6. There will be an optional Senior Singles event. Bowler's scores bowled in the Team event of the County Tournament will be used to determine the winners of this event. There will be an additional prize fee of \$12.00 for the event. There will be 3 divisions as follows: Age 50-59, Age 60-69, & Age 70 and older.
- 7a. Lane assignments for the doubles and team events will be assigned by tournament management.
- 7b. Lane assignments for walk-ins in both the doubles and team events will be assigned by tournament management.
8. Parental Consent: Those not yet 18 years of age who are unmarried, grade or high school students, become eligible to compete in the tournament, one week following the filing of a written authorization by a parent or legal guardian, unless accompanied by a parent or guardian in which case the Parental Consent forms may be filled out up to the time the student is scheduled to bowl.
9. In the event of lane malfunction, the tournament director reserve the right to move bowlers to other lanes and the match will continue from the same point.
10. There shall be 10 minutes of practice prior to the starting time of each squad on your starting lanes.
11. Upon dressing the lanes for tournament use, open practice shall not be allowed on lanes scheduled for use in the tournament that day.
12. Bowlers arriving late will begin play with the frame then being bowled. Missed frames cannot be made up and will be scored zero.
13. In the case of a tie in any position, prize money for those positions will be combined and divided equally.
14. All prize money will be returned 100%. It will be split on a 60/40 basis between handicap(60) and scratch(40) except in the senior event where only a handicapped prize is paid.
- 15a. One prize will be paid for each 7 entries or major portion thereof in both handicap & scratch of each event (i.e. Team, Singles, And Doubles).
- 15b. One prize will be paid for each 10 entries or major portion thereof in both the OPTIONAL scratch and handicap ALL EVENTS.
- 15c. One prize will be paid for each 7 entries or major portion thereof in each division of the SENIOR event.
16. All entry money must accompany application.
 - a. Applications without money or complete listing of leagues bowled in the current year will be voided.
 - b. Contestants must list USBC BOWLER ID NUMBER in space allotted.
 - c. No one will be entitled to any refund after entry fees have been received and definite dates and times have been assigned.
17. Bowlers competing in the Minor Events will bowl doubles first then singles in that order.
- 18a. All team captains must check in, showing each individual's sanction card, at least 30 minutes before their scheduled time. Report all substitutions to Tournament Manager at least 30 minutes before squad time.
- 18b. Walk-ins will be accepted until 20 minutes before scheduled squad starting times. There is an additional fee of \$5.00 for each bowler for each event.
19. Entrants may bowl with more than (1) four-person team, but there may not be more than (2) of the same persons on any other team. Bowlers may compete as many times as they want in the Doubles Event, providing they change partners and they enter the Single Event for every time they enter the Doubles Event. Your first score counts towards the All Events.
20. All entries mailed must be postmarked by midnight on the Thursday prior to the date to be bowled. All other entries will be considered walk-ins and assigned lanes as available.
21. Lanes shall be dressed daily (according to agreement between the BCUSBCBA and the BOWLING ESTABLISHMENT).
22. USBC Chevrons shall be awarded.
23. Only (1) PBA card-carrying member per 4-person Team and Doubles pair.
24. If a situation occurs and is not covered under any BCUSBCBA Tournament rules, USBC Rules apply. Decisions on items not covered by USBC will be handled by the tournament management.
